第一单元

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第一课 汉语拼音复习*

同学们，三年级的时候我们已经学习了汉语拼音，今天，我们要复习汉语拼音，并且学习用拼音在电脑上输入汉字。

记得吗，我们说过读汉语拼音和读英文很相像，但是也有一些不同。下面列出它们的主要区别，复习后请在每一项后面的方框里打上勾：

一、英文没有声调(tones)，而汉语拼音有。

二、英文有元音(vowels)和辅音(consonants)，拼音有声母(initials)和韵母(finals)。韵母(finals)和元音(vowels)很像，但不完全相同。声母(initials)和辅音(consonants)很像，但也不完全相同。拼音有六个单韵母(simple finals)：

a, o, e, i, u, ü

三、英文里的每个元音字母都可能有好几种发音，而在拼音里，一个单韵母(simple final)基本上只有一个发音。(只有两处例外(exceptions): *i* 在 *z, c, s, r, zh, ch, sh* 后面时只标音调不发声；*u* 在 *j, q, x* 后面时发 *ü* 声)。

* 五年级第一单元(第一至第四课)的内容是复习拼音、学习用拼音输入汉字和查字典等，主要以学生自学为主。为了保障阅读的顺畅，在课文行文中加注了一些拼音。第一单元之后的其他课文将恢复不加拼音的惯例。

四、拼音里有固定的复韵母 (compound finals) 组合。

九个基本普通复韵母是：

ai, ao, ei, ou, ia, ie, ua, uo, üe

它们的延伸是 (they can be derived into):

uai(i+ai), iao(i+ao), iu(i+ou), ui(u+ei)

十、复习汉语拼音的主要目的(main purpose), 是为了学习在电脑上用拼音输入汉字。在英文键盘(keyboard)上没有 ü 键, 当汉字拼音中出现字母 ü 的时候, 我们可以键入“v”。例如绿色的“绿”字, 拼音为“lù”, 我们在键盘上键入“lv”就可以输入“绿”字了。(但是, 键盘上只能用“v”输入带字母“ü”的汉字, 而不能单独输入“ü”这个字母)。

A Summary of Pinyin

Now we have taught ourselves Chinese Pinyin. The following is a summary of the main points:

1. Unlike in English, we have tones in Chinese. The four tone signs are put above the six simple finals -- **a, o, e, i, u, and ü**.
2. The term “simple final” in Pinyin is almost the same as the term “vowel” in English. While in English the same vowel may sound different in different words, in Chinese a simple final always sounds the same with only two exceptions:
 - a. When “i” comes after **z, c, s, r, zh, ch, and sh**, it doesn’t have a sound at all. It is only there to carry the tone sign.
 - b. When “ü” comes after **j, q, and x**, it is written as “u.”
3. In Pinyin there are two groups of basic compound finals, each with nine members.
4. The members in the first group are:
ai, ia, ao, ou, uo, ua, ei, ie, and ue.

From them we can make other compound finals such as **iao** (i+ao), **uai** (u+ai), **iu** (i+ou), and **ui** (u+ei).

5. The members in the second group of basic compound finals are called nasal finals:
an, ang, en, eng, in, ing, ong, un, and ün.
- From them we can make other compound finals such as **ian** (i+an), **iang** (i+ang), **uan** (u+an), **uang** (u+ang), **ueng** (u+eng), **üan** (ü+an), and **iong** (i+ong).
6. In Pinyin there is a special final: **er**. It always appears alone, never with any initial. The four characters with final **er** that we have learned are: 二(èr), 耳(ér), 儿(ér), and 而(ér).
7. The term “initial” in Pinyin is almost the same as the term “consonant” in English. Please pay attention to the following Pinyin initials since they sound different from how they do in English:
j, q, x, z, c, zh, ch, and sh.
8. The following three initials sound slightly different from how they do in English:
b, d, and g.
9. When spelling a character, the simple finals i, u, and ü can’t stand alone, but have to follow another leading letter. For example **i = yi** (一), **u = wu** (五), and **ü = yu** (鱼).
10. When spelling a character, the simple finals i, u, and ü can’t be the first letter, but have to transform into other letters. For example **ia = ya** (牙); **ie = ye** (叶); **iou = you** (有), **ua = wa** (蛙), **uo = wo** (我), **ue = we** (为), **üe = ye** (月), **üan = yuan** (圆)。
